**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLIES TO RESPONDENTS'
AND INTERVENOR/RESPONDENT'S RETURNS TO APPELLANT'S
MOTION TO ALTER OR AMEND ORDER OF APRIL 29, 2022**

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Pursuant to Rule 263 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellant requests that the Court extend the deadline for Appellant to file replies to returns of Respondents and Intervenor-Respondent to the Appellant's Motion to Alter or Amend Order of April 29, 2022 in Appellate Case No. 2021-000837.

Rule 240 provides that a moving party shall have five (5) days from the date of service of a return to a movant's motion to file a reply. Rule 263 permits the Court to expand the time for filing such a reply under the Appellate Court Rules.

Both Respondents and Intervenor-Respondent served their returns to Appellant's Motion to Alter or Amend Order of April 29, 2022 on June 10, 2022, making Appellant's replies due on June 17, 2022. Appellant requests a five-day extension, which would result in a new deadline of June 24, 2022 pursuant to Rules 240(f) and 263(a). Appellant has not previously requested an extension of this deadline.

Respondents and Intervenor-Respondent consent to the requested extension to the extent a reply is permitted.
