MOTION FOR JUDICIAL
NOTICE AND LEAVE TO FILE
RULE 60(b), SCRPC, MOTION, AND
Newly Discovered Evidence

Appellate, Alonzo C. Jeter, III, hereby respectfully seeks that this Court would take Judicial notice that Appellate has obtained newly discovered evidence which is relative to this action for post-conviction relief. (See 50 page Newly Discovered Evidence).

Specifically, Appellant has after diligent effort, obtained the drug analysis relative to the controlled buys in this case. Appellant experienced undue hardship in his attempts to obtain the drug analysis from the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division, due to: (1) SLED's refusal to provide the drug analysis

to Appellant as he requested as a pro se litigant specifying that the material is needed in Appellant's pro se litigation; (2) SLED's refusal to provide the drug analysis to Appellant as he alternatively requested under South Carolina's Freedom of Information Act; (3) Appellant's ineffective post-conviction relief counsel's failure and refusal to subpoena the drug analysis or any other evidence to support Appellant's PCR claims; (4) the post-conviction relief Court's refusal to provide an order for discovery due to its erroneously determining that Appellant was seeking this discovery to challenge the weight of the evidence (however, Appellant was rather seeking to demonstrate Plea Counsel's failure to investigate).

The SLED drug analysis does support Appellant's claim that there were two controlled buys rather than three, and also that the controlled buys were temporally connected as they were the result of one agreement at genesis of the investigation.


Appellant has attempted to do speedy research in effort to comprehend how to inform the Court of this newly discovered evidence and how to motion that the Courts would provide Judicial notice and allow the newly discovered evidence to be entered into the record and fairly considered in adjudication.

Appellant was only able to recently as of the 21st day of March, 2022, obtain this proof as a family friend

obtained this public record drug analysis through SLED by way of South Carolina's Freedom of Information Act. (See also pending case Alonzo C. Jeter, III, v SLED, CA No. 2021-CP-40-0430)

Appellant asks that this Court would take judicial notice of this matter, allow this newly discovered evidence to be entered into the record, allow Appellant to file a Rule 60(b), SCRPC, motion, etc. in the lower court, and consider this as this is in fact genuine material evidence in support of Plea Counsel and PCR Counsel's ineffectiveness and failure to investigate and represent Appellant in a meaningful way. This would also show the PCR Court's abuse of discretion in this regard.

Virginia still appeared to be very upset so myself and Dep.Bowles spoke to her to try and put her at ease .Virginia stated that if we could, would we just go out and speak to them and try to figure out what this man was about because this man made her afraid for some reason .Myself and Dep.Bowles walked out to an outbuilding in which Alonzo was in , I knocked on the door of the building and heard someone say ,Who is it ,I advised them that it was the Sheriffs Office , at that time Dep.Bowles went around to the other side of the building .After a few minutes I heard Dep.Bowles state for me to come around back .I then went to the back and observed Alonzo and a white male inside the building .By now Aaron was speaking to the white male about something he had seen him trying to hide . Aaron told me once he got to the speaker that he saw Crystal Ice inside that speaker , At that time we called for narcotics Sgt. B. Gardner to come out to the location . In speaking to Alonzo and Mr.Long both of them stated that the meth was not theirs .At that time both were placed under arrest for this offense .

Deputy Owens attempted to make contact with Jeter by knocking on the door. After hearing an inordinate pause from within the building, I went to the back to make sure no one ran out of the back door. Jeter opened the door and presented himself. He began acting suspiciously as he appeared shocked to see me standing there despite announcing ourselves as law enforcement officers. Jeter then placed his right hand in his pocket. I ordered him to remove his hand for safety concerns to which he placed both hands behind his back which also concerned me. While engaging Jeter, I observed movement from within the building directly behind the door. Fearing for my safety, I ordered the occupant to come to the door with negative results. I attempted to enter the building however Jeter attempted to block the doorway. I observed Long pick up what appeared to be a plastic bag with his left hand then concealing it by palming it in his right hand. I ordered Long to put the item down. Long continued to make furtive movements with the concealed item. I presented my Taser and continued to give verbal commands to Long who then placed the item behind a set of large speakers near his position. Once Deputy Owens came to the back of the building, I detained Long who briefly resisted me with passive resistance. I placed Long into handcuffs and then observed the speaker to contain a partially opened bag of translucent crystalline flakes on top of a set of digital scales. I placed Long under arrest and read him his Miranda warning. Deputy Owens detained Jeter on my request.

I contacted Sgt. Brandon Gardner who arrived on scene to assist in my investigation. Next to the bed, in plain view, I observed an open plastic bag containing green plant like material believed to be marijuana.

Due to Jeter's recent arrest for methamphetamine and the suspected sales of methamphetamine on this incident date, I seized Jeter and Long's cellular phones as they may possess evidentiary value.



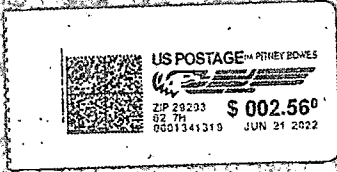
