Extension Request


NOW COMES the Petitioner in the above captioned Post-Conviction Relief matter, acting by and through his undersigned counsel, requesting a thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file his Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix thereto. The Notice of Appeal from the Order of Dismissal in Petitioner's Post-Conviction Relief action was filed on May 24, 2022. Petitioner ordered and received a transcript of his PCR hearing held on June 14, 2021, before there was an Order entered in this PCR action.
