

## ORDER

Petitioner has filed a notice of appeal from the denial of his application for post-conviction relief (PCR). Sarah Shipe, of the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense, Division of Appellate Defense, who is currently representing Petitioner in this matter, seeks appointment of outside counsel due to a conflict of interest arising from Petitioner's allegation that Robert M. Dudek, also employed by the Division of Appellate Defense as the Chief Appellate Defender, was ineffective in his representation of Petitioner on direct appeal.

The motion is granted, and Ms. Shipe is relieved as counsel. Jonathan Waller, who represented Petitioner before the PCR court, is appointed to represent Petitioner in this matter.
