MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for David Crockett Robinson respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension until July 27, 2022**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for David Crockett Robinson respectfully submits that extraordinary

circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the Return to the State's Motion to Dismiss and Motion to Vacate the Published Opinion in the case of In the Interest of Christopher H., A Juvenile with the Supreme Court on June 7, 2022. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Amy Berridge v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 3, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Jordan Marie Hodge v. The State with the Court of Appeals on May 26, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of William Bruce Justice v. The State with the Court of Appeals on May 19, 2022. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Milciades Alcantara v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 6, 2022. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Xavier U. Brannon v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 2, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




