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MEMORANDUM

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, Appellants Lonnie Hamilton, III and Zoe’Lia L. Culbreath (“Appellants”) respectfully move for an extension of time in which to request the transcript for the proceeding for which the decision being appealed is based, in accordance with Rule 207, SCACR.
