MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE

This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.



Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Eric Emanuel English with the Supreme Court of June 3, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


