Dear Mr. Crawford:

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The title page does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title should also read as follows:

**Russell Crawford, Appellant,**

**v.**

**Raymond Babich, Respondent.**

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

- Pursuant to Rule 208(b), SCACR, the brief shall contain under appropriate headings and in the order indicated: 1) Table of Contents and Cases, 2) Statement of Issues on Appeal, 3) Statement of the Case, 4) Standard of Review, 5) Argument, and 6) Conclusion.
- When filing the final brief, only the cover page should be blue. All other pages should be white copy paper.
