Dear Ms. Hackett:

I was transferred from Lee C.I. to Lieber C.I. on 4/30/13. I ask that you send all future correspondence to my new and current address at Lieber.

I have attempted to call you via the institutions automated telephone system three times since our last telephone conversation. I have not been successful in reaching you. I also sent you a letter on 4/17/13 and have gotten no response. But perhaps it is due to the ongoing and persistent problems with the delays and other problems with the mailroom at Lee C.I. Thus, I am writing you this new letter.

We looked up your current caseload and have found that it is, on average, TEN TIMES what is considered allowable, which brings me to the question: Are you able to be effective and give my case the attention and work-time necessary? I have performed some basic calculations, and were liberal on your behalf in them, and I cannot comprehend how you are able to give each case the attention and research (even basic) needed to be helpful to each client. I simply do not see how you do it. Perhaps those issues are in direct correlation to the remainder of this letter.

I have no idea or knowledge as to what is happening with our direct appeal process. I do not know if you have filed any motions or other paperwork. Have you submitted any briefs?

If so, what issues did you raise? If not, what issues do you plan on raising? Have you contacted any of the affiants involving the juror misconduct? If so, what's happening with that?

As for my missing testimony from the Jackson v. Denno hearing: Have you acquired that yet? I have access to archive pictures of me on the stand, giving testimony, at the Jackson v. Denno hearing, do you need those? I also have several witnesses who were present at the hearing, who heard me give testimony, do you need affidavits from them?

Ms. Hackett, am I allowed to be actively involved in my case? Am I allowed to actively participate in the decision making process concerning my direct appeal, and if so, how?

Do you feel that you can adequately conduct the necessary research and find the proper time to effectively perfect my appeal?

Also, I still have not received any response from you concerning my letter to you about the transcripts and other legal effects I am missing as the result of an improper cell search on 1/25/13. I have an appeal pending with the ALC. I have submitted a motion for an extension of time and a motion for discovery to the Court (ALC). An argument I intend to raise in my ALC initial brief is concerning these missing/stolen legal effects and I am seeking the replacement thereof. For your reference, here is my ALC case information: Case Numbers - 13C0312-IJ; 13C0313-IJ.

I have put forth twelve questions to you in this letter. Please take the time to answer each one, if you are able.

I do greatly value your time and response.



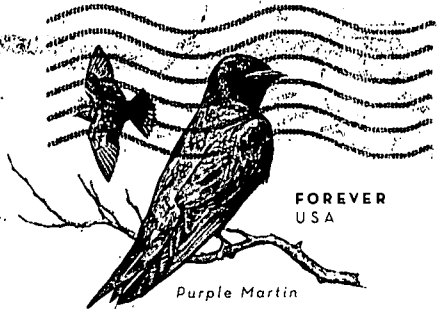

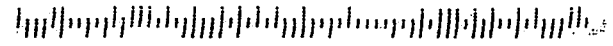
