MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH
TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Bradley Mark Corlew respectfully requests a **final extension of twenty (20) days, from June 30, 2022, until July 20, 2022**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case. **Counsel will file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter before the deadline if possible.** In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed today, June 30, 2022. The Court has granted counsel four previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Bradley Mark Corlew respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. **Counsel recently missed six days of work due to illness.**


3. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Kyle Maurice Robinson in the Court of Appeals on June 16, 2022. Counsel presented on the topics of Transcript Review and Issue Spotting and Ethics for the PCR Attorney for the South Carolina Indigent Defense Academy's Post-Conviction Relief Training CLE held on June 10, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. John William McCarty in the Supreme Court on June 8, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Denzell Deshawn Jackson in the Court of Appeals on June 6, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Sidney Stclair Moorer in the Supreme Court on May 17, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Boyd Rashaen Evans v. State in the Supreme Court on May 17, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Decota Castle Brown in the Court of Appeals on May 5, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant, designation of matter, and record on appeal in the case of State v. David Graves in the Court of Appeals on April 26, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.






