MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Justin Lamont Bradley respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until August 4, 2022**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Justin Lamont Bradley respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Andre Green v. The State with the Court of Appeals on July 1, 2022. Counsel filed the Return to the State's Motion to Dismiss and Motion to Vacate the Published Opinion in the case of In the Interest of Christopher H., A Juvenile with the Supreme Court on June 7, 2022. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Amy Berridge v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 3, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On June 30, 2022, opposing counsel, the Office of the Attorney General, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through July 31, 2022.


