MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Odom Bryant respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days until August 5, 2022 in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Odom Bryant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances

exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Petition for Writ of Certiorari Pursuant to Austin v. State in the case of Aryee Henderson v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 29, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Holly Jo Thompson v. The State with the South Carolina Supreme Court on June 13, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Worth Edward Cook, III v. The State with the Court of Appeals on June 7, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. On June 30, 2022, opposing counsel, the Office of the Attorney General, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through July 31, 2022.
