Dear Ms. Webb:

We received your emails dated June 27 and July 1, 2022. On March 2, 2022, this Court issued an opinion disposing of this appeal. When a petition for rehearing was not actually received by the Court of Appeals, we sent the remittitur on March 23, 2022. *See* Rule 221(a), SCACR ("Petitions for rehearing must be actually received by the appellate court no later than fifteen (15) days after the filing of the opinion, order, judgment, or decree of the court."); Rule 221(b), SCACR ("The remittitur shall contain a copy of the judgment of the appellate court, shall be sealed with the seal and signed by the clerk of the court, and unless otherwise ordered by the court shall not be sent to the lower court or administrative tribunal until fifteen (15) days have elapsed (the day of filing being excluded) since the filing of the opinion, order, judgment, or decree of the court finally disposing of the appeal."). The sending of remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction in this case. We will not take any further action on your filings.
