

Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Petition for Writ of Certiorari Pursuant to Austin v. State in the case of Aryee Henderson v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 29, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Holly Jo Thompson v. The State with the South Carolina Supreme Court on June 13, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Worth Edward Cook, III v. The State with the Court of Appeals on June 7, 2022. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Michael A. Williams with the Court of Appeals on May 25, 2022. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Amy N. Taylor on May 12, 2022.

5. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


