On June 17, 2022, I received notice from Daniel W. Hayes, Esquire that the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) had finally reached a determination as to the parties' Medicare Set Aside (MSA) proposal. Specifically, CMS concluded adequate protection of Medicare's future interests would require allocation of a sum somewhat higher than our proposed figure. Mr. Hayes also shared this information with Ben Renfrow, counsel for Respondents, through a copy of his email notification.


Last week, Mr. Hayes provided counsel with a follow-up email seeking confirmation as to the status of the additional funding required by CMS. This afternoon, I forwarded Mr. Renfrow a revised Settlement Order incorporating the revisions necessitated by CMS' action.
