1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today, having been extended by one prior order of this Court.



writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Isiah T. Smith v. State in this Court on April 18, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Hazel Stoudemire v. State in this Court on April 13, 2012. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Demetrick McQueen in the Court of Appeals on April 12, 2012. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Kevin J. Williams, Sr. in the Court of Appeals on April 10, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Albert C. Smith, II v. State in this Court on April 9, 2012. In March, 2012, Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Lewis D. Williams, as well as the petitions for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendices in the cases of Lenson Clyburn, Jr. v. State, Glenn Pernell v. State, Sylvester Toomer v. 


