MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for petitioner respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for petitioner respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Donald Ray Richburg with the Supreme Court on June 17, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Damien Lavar Ritter with the Court of Appeals on June 17, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Tammy Dianne Brown with the Court of Appeals on June 9, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Lance Antonio Brewton with the Court of Appeals on June 9, 2022. Counsel, as co-counsel, filed a petition for a stay of execution in the death penalty case of The State v. Jerome Jenkins, Jr., with the Supreme Court on June 7, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of The State v. Joshua Cw Reher with the Supreme Court on May 26, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Justin Jamal Warner with the Supreme Court on April 28, 2022. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Victoria Lorraine Sanchez with the Supreme Court on April 27, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the thirty day general consent granted by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through November 30, 2020. That emailed general consent was dated October 28, 2020.
