
If you choose not to represent Mr. Goodwin in this appeal, this Court requires a copy of an order issued in the lower court showing that you have been relieved as counsel or an original petition to be relieved as counsel, proof of service on opposing counsel and Clarence Goodwin, Jr., and a fifty dollar (\$50) filing fee, must be filed with this Court, pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR.

Furthermore, this case is not immediately appealable to this Court unless the parties consent pursuant to § 62-1-308(l) of the South Carolina Code of Laws (Supp. 2020).

We request that you advise the Court of the status of your representation of

Clarence Goodwin, Jr. and whether the parties consent to appealing to this Court within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
