**MOTION FOR FOURTH EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH

**I.**

The Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter are due to be served and filed on May 20, 2013.

**II.**

Pursuant to RE: Extension Requests in Criminal Direct Appeals and Post-Conviction Relief Certiorari Proceedings: Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009, the Appellant moves for a fourth extension in the above-referenced criminal appeal and asks for an additional seven days to complete the brief in this case. ### III.


