Marchbanks respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension until August 15, 2022, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel filed the Return to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of

Appeals in the case of Phillip Lowery v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 11, 2022. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Andre Green v. The State with this Court on July 1, 2022. Counsel filed the Return to Motion to Dismiss and Motion to Vacate the Published Opinion in the case of In the Interest of Christopher H., A Juvenile with the Supreme Court on June 7, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of Amy Berridge v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 3, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Jordan Marie Hodge v. The State with this Court on May 26, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of William Bruce Justice v. The State with this Court on May 19, 2022.


3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. On June 30, 2022, opposing counsel, the Office of the Attorney General, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through July 31, 2022.


