MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Correy Tremayne Brown respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from July 18, 2022 until August 17, 2022**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Correy Tremayne Brown respectfully submits that extraordinary

circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the return to petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Sylvester Ferguson III with the Court of Appeals on June 27, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Johnathan Lamar Hillary before the Court of Appeals on June 15, 2022. Counsel was a speaker on proposed orders and Rule 59(e), motions at the IDCA Post-Conviction Relief CLE on June 10, 2022, at the office of the Commission on Indigent Defense. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. John Thomas Basile with the Court of Appeals on June 3, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Mark R. Volstromer with the Court of Appeals on May 31, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of James Gregory Younger with the Court of Appeals on May 23, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. On June 30, 2022, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through July 31, 2022.




