Dear, South Carolina Court of Appeals my name is Jeremiah Daishawn Wright, I am just now receiving a letter stating I have (20) days from today to explain why I'm requesting for an appeal, first and foremost I would like to say that I'm truly sorry for the victim & the family. I'm NOT a murderer NOR did I intend to take the life of another person! The only reason I didn't take my case to trial is because my lawyer said he did not feel comfortable taking my case to trial, I also feared of being wrongly convicted and sentenced to life. There is a lot of misjudgement and dishonesty thats going on in my case and I want the TRUTH to come to the light. I feel like law enforcement didn't do a proper investigation. An Assault Rifle was found with a spent shell casing on the crime scene the same day the shooting took place it was the same Assault Rifle that the victim shot at me. The bullet was never recovered and the victim some how didn't have any (GSR) on his hands Also a witness that was on the scene but nowhere near the shooting tested positive for (GSR). I can truly say that I had a no contact order with the Court stating I couldn't see or be around the mother of my child but I also have proof that she was coming to my house spending the night and law enforcement never got called. I had permission from the head of the house that I could go pick my daughter up for her first halloween.

I never forced an entry I was let inside the house. I have phone call records to prove that. The witnesses in my case are NOT credible. The main reason that I'm asking for an appeal is because I don't think that 26 years was a reasonable sentence for me I understand that I pleaded guilty to an open plea for 20-30 year's but that's because I felt like I had no choice, my lawyer was pressuring me to take the plea or I would get life. I feel like he was not comfortable fighting my case. I know that I have to serve some time for my actions but I'm asking may I please have a chance to explain the truth of what really happen. I have a 2 year old daughter I haven't seen since she was 7 months I would like to see my daughter grow up instead of not being able to be there and her not know who her father is.
