

An investigation began on the listed subject, Alonzo Jeter for a purchase of 14 grams of methamphetamine. An undercover operative cooperating with the Cherokee County Sheriff's Narcotics Division made several phone calls in reference to this purchase and the recordings from the phone conversations are included in the case file. On January 13, 2015 a phone call was made in which the undercover operative and Mr. Jeter discussed a price of \$800 and set up a meeting on the following day for the purchase. One the following day, January 14, 2015 there were four phone calls placed in which a time was set up to meet, and included one phone conversation that Mr. Jeter told the undercover operative to come to his address on Malone Rd around noon. The undercover operative was searched as well as the vehicle he would be traveling in and given instructions on what to do. The undercover operative was equipped with an audio/video camera and given \$800. (a copy of the audio/video recordings from this camera are included in the case file. The undercover operative meets with Mr. Jeter at the listed incident location and exchanges money that he had been provided for an "B ball" of believed to be methamphetamine from Mr. Jeter, which is approximately 3.4 grams. During the transaction Mr. Jeter explains to the undercover operative that he ran out of the rest of methamphetamine, but discusses a price and time for them to meet again for the transaction of the rest of the 14 grams of methamphetamine. The undercover operative then leaves the incident location and drives a short distance to meet back with Sgt. Gardner and other Detectives in the Narcotics Division. Sgt. Gardner took custody of the believed to be methamphetamine and after the camera equipment was powered off the undercover operative was searched to ensure nothing else illegal was in his/her possession and the believed to be methamphetamine was placed into the evidence drop box to be sent to SLED for testing.

Narrative

An investigation began on the listed subject, Alonzo Jeter for a purchase of 14 grams of methamphetamine after an initial purchase of a smaller amount of methamphetamine occurred between the undercover operative and Mr. Jeter on 1/12/15 (case #1500183). After conversation between the undercover operative and Mr. Jeter in which a discussion of a purchase of a larger amount of methamphetamine was discussed. The undercover operative cooperating with the Cherokee County Sheriff's Narcotics Division made several phone calls in reference to this purchase and the recordings from the phone conversations are included in the case file. On January 13, 2015 a phone call was made in which the undercover operative and Mr. Jeter discussed a price of \$800 and set up a meeting on the following day for the purchase. One the following day, January 14, 2015 there were four phone calls placed in which a time was set up to meet, and included one phone conversation that Mr. Jeter told the undercover operative to come to his address on Malone Rd around noon. The undercover operative was searched as well as the vehicle he would be traveling in and given instructions on what to do. The undercover operative was equipped with an audio/video camera and given \$800. (a copy of the audio/video recordings from this camera are included in the case file for case #1500226. The undercover operative meets with Mr. Jeter at the listed incident location and exchanges money that he had been provided for an "8 ball" of believed to be methamphetamine from Mr. Jeter, which is approximately 3.4 grams. During the transaction Mr. Jeter explains to the undercover operative that he ran out of the rest of methamphetamine, but discusses a price and time for them to meet again for the transaction of the rest of the 14 grams of methamphetamine. The undercover operative then leaves the incident location and drives a short distance to meet back with Sgt. Gardner and other Detectives in the Narcotics Division. Sgt. Gardner took custody of the believed to be methamphetamine and after the camera equipment was powered off the undercover operative was searched to ensure nothing else illegal was in his/her possession and the believed to be methamphetamine was placed into the evidence drop box to be sent to SLED for testing. This incident in reference to case # 1500226.

On the date of this incident, the undercover operative meet with Sgt. Gardner and other detectives in the Narcotics Division a phone call was made from the undercover operative to Mr. Jeter in reference to the undercover operative purchasing the remaining amount of the 14 grams of methamphetamine that had been discussed on prior occasions. This recording is included in the case file. The undercover operative was searched as well as the vehicle he would be traveling in and given instructions on what to do. The undercover operative was equipped with two audio/video devices and given \$800. (a copy of the audio/video recordings from these devices are included in the case file. The undercover operative meets with Mr. Jeter at the listed incident location and exchanges money that he had been provided for approximately a little more than 11 grams of methamphetamine. The undercover operative then leaves the incident location and drives a short distance to meet back with Sgt. Gardner and other Detectives in the Narcotics Division. Sgt. Gardner took custody of the believed to be methamphetamine and after the camera equipment was powered off the undercover operative was searched to ensure nothing else illegal was in his/her possession and the believed to be methamphetamine was placed into the evidence drop box to be sent to SLED for testing.


