MOTION TO EXTEND TIME

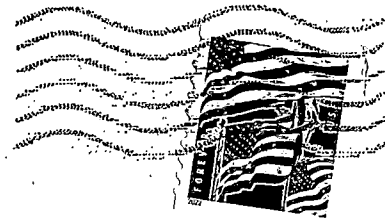

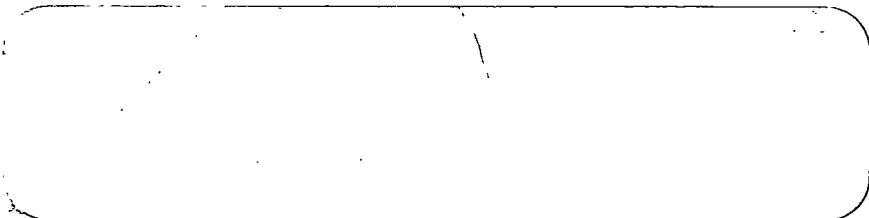
