

Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. John Thomas Basile with the Court of Appeals on June 3, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Mark R. Volstromer with the Court of Appeals on May 31, 2022.

3. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. Opposing counsel Matthew Buchanan, Esquire, has graciously consented to, or does not oppose this extension.
