

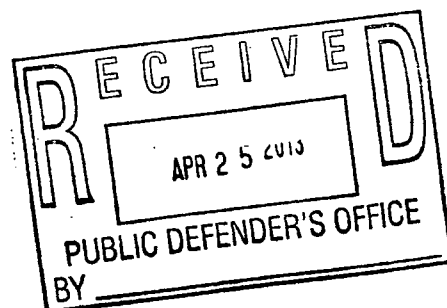

Enclosed please find a copy of a letter my office received from a client I represented on the above-listed case.

Following his trial, which concluded on April 10, 2013, Mr. Cash was sentenced to ten (10) years and given credit for the time he has served thus far. Mr. Cash did not, at that time, notify me of an interest in appealing his case. My office received a letter from him on April 25, 2013 regarding an interest in pursuing an appeal. A copy of the letter is enclosed, and has been dated April 16, 2013 by Mr. Cash.

My office received a separate copy of the same letter which was forwarded from the Florence County Clerk of Court's office. A copy of this letter is also enclosed, and appears to have been received by the Clerk's office on April 19, 2013. It was then received by my office on May 2, 2013.

I was not aware of Mr. Cash's intent to file an appeal until well after the ten (10) day period for filing lapsed, but it appears he notified the Clerk of Court's office of his intent to appeal in a timely matter.
