

This notice is in response to the letter that was sent in by Cameodiamond Elizabeth Joseph, Esq attorney in regard to the transcript for case number: 2021-000770

I never had the opportunity for a proper trial to have a transcript on record. The first hearing was held through a Zoom call based on a motion that was filed by the Greenville Hospital System and Greenville County Detention Center regarding their motion to dismiss the case. We addressed their concerns with the courts along with providing the documentation that was necessary to proceed with the lawsuit.

The court was made aware that due to COVID and the fact that a lot of law offices were shut down, I was restricted on obtaining an attorney to properly file a lawsuit and issue a letter of intent and had to complete it to the best of my abilities to ensure that my time would not expire. My attorney made the courts aware that I still had the proper time to file the necessary documents and the lawsuit that was filed could serve as a letter on intent. She also advised that I could still withdrawal the lawsuit and amend it and still meet the statutory timeline requirements. Also COVID should have extended the times limits based on the inability to seek proper counsel and serve required documents. The judge for this case, stated that he would review the documents and make his determination on the order. The judge then sent in an electronic ruling where I was not given the opportunity to argue my position or go forward with a trial. We filed a reconsideration which was denied and prevented the opportunity to proceed with this matter.

Therefore, when I requested for a transcript, I was advised by the Greenville County Clerk of Court that one did not exist because the judge made his ruling electronically. Being that this case was only heard through a Zoom meeting for a motion to dismiss, we never had the opportunity to go to trial to have a transcript produced.

We would also like to request for an extension of time to complete the appellant initial brief and designation of matter.
