I was assigned to do the transcript because I am certified to do official transcripts through the DCRP program. Some court monitors are not certified to do the transcripts, but only run the machines. I am guessing that your court reporter is not certified to do transcripts because if she was she would have gotten the request. The DCRP assigns certified court reporters to do the official transcript off of the recordings. I can assure you it will be accurate as long as the audio is clear and everyone was speaking into the microphone. I have been doing my job for over 17 years now, so I have the experience to do it. That being said, I will copy this e-mail to court administration and if you still wish to be assigned another court reporter, you can ask court administration if they will give it to another court reporter.
