**SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR APPELLANTS  
TO SERVE AND FILE INITIAL BRIEF  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

**COME NOW** the Appellants, Pamela Holliday Wallin, Mark Bennett Holliday, Kingsley K. Holliday, Sara Jane Holliday, and John C. Holliday (collectively “Appellants”), and hereby request a **thirty (30) day extension** of time to serve and file their Initial Brief and Designation of Matter upon the Appellant, respectfully showing as follows:

1. This is Appellants’ second request for extension.

2. An order granting Appellants' first extension was issued July 6, 2022, with an amended due date of August 8, 2022.

3. The Appellants request this additional extension due to the unforeseen circumstance that the undersigned counsel, who is responsible for the briefing, was recently quarantined and symptomatic with COVID-19, having tested positive on July 26, 2022 and remaining out of the office until August 2, 2022. This limited counsel's work on the briefing ahead of the upcoming deadline.

4. Additionally, counsel has a family vacation to the west coast, which has been booked and paid for, between the dates of August 6 and August 13, 2022.

5. Although counsel will be engaged in efforts to grade the July 2022 South Carolina Bar Exam as chairman of the Board of Law Examiners during the period covered by this requested extension, this is not expected to interfere with his ability to complete the briefing and designation of matter within this additional time.

6. Appellants notified all counsel of their request for this extension in advance of its filing.

WHEREFORE, Appellants respectfully request that this Court issue an Order granting them an additional thirty (30) day extension of time to serve and file their Initial Brief and Designation of Matter, making it due on September 7, 2022.
