The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

On 12/28/2018 at approx. 2344hrs, a victim contacted the Myrtle Beach Police Department to report an armed robbery that occurred on this same date at approx. 2200hrs while in the area of [redacted] which is located within the City limits of Myrtle Beach. Officers responded to [redacted] to speak to the victim about the incident. Further investigation revealed the victim was driving on [redacted] at a slow rate of speed when two unknown suspects approached the vehicle. Victim was sitting on the driver's seat when the first taller suspect, later identified as the co-defendant, pulled open the passenger side door and leaned inside the vehicle while holding a black handgun pointing towards the right side of the victim's head. The second suspect, later identified as the Defendant, approached the driver's side window and pointing a black handgun towards the left side of the victim's head while at the same time demanding money from the victim. Victim gave the defendant a wallet containing credit cards and approx. \$80 in cash while the first suspect, co-defendant, took away the victim's iPhone from the center console. Victim drove away after the robbery and later arrived at a hotel to report the incident to the police. On 12/30/2018, the co-defendant was arrested for another Armed Robbery incident where the co-defendant used a social media app called Grinder to lure another victim on 12/27/2018 at a nearby apartment complex called [redacted] which is also within the city limits of Myrtle Beach. In a post Miranda interview, the co-defendant admitted to using the Grinder app to communicate to three different people in the past three days and all three people have been identified as victims of armed robbery in the city including this victim on 12/28/18. Co-Defendant placed himself and the defendant in the area and time of the armed robbery reported by the victim. Furthermore, the co-defendant positivity identified the Grinder photo as himself when presented with the same photo that a different victim had provided as the suspect to law enforcement on 12/27/2018. Based upon the stated facts, that the defendant did participate in concert with a co-defendant in a robbery with a deadly weapon, there is probable cause to believe the defendant did commit the offense of Armed Robbery, 16-11-330.

The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

On 12/27/2018 at approx. 2200hrs, Victim contacted the Myrtle Beach Police Department to report an armed robbery that occurred on this date at approx. 2030hrs in the area of [REDACTED] which is located within the city limits of Myrtle Beach. Victim had used a social media app called Grindr to meet the Co-Defendant at the incident location earlier that night. Victim arrived at the incident location at around 2030hrs and was sitting in a vehicle when approached by two suspects, later identified as the Defendant and Co-Defendant. Victim stated both suspects pointed a black in color handgun towards him while they took away money and a cellphone from his possession. Victim said he drove away after the robbery to a hotel and contacted the police to report the incident. Victim located a photograph from Grindr and provided it to law enforcement. Victim positively identified a Co-defendant's Grindr photograph as the same suspect present with a handgun during the commission of the armed robbery. A SLED Facial recognition indicated the Grindr photo as a possible match for the co-defendant and a SC DMV photo confirmed the co-defendant's identity.

On 12/30/2018, A third Co-defendant was found in possession of a black and silver BB gun during a stop near [REDACTED] shortly after the arrest of a co-defendant. This BB gun that was in possession of the co-defendant matched the same gun description used during the armed robbery reported by the victim. In Post Miranda interviews, both co-defendants positively identify the defendant as being present during the date and time of the armed robbery reported by the victim on 12/27/2018 at the [REDACTED] and of another armed robbery incident that occurred on 12/29/2018 at Somerset Drive.

Based upon the stated facts, that the defendant did participate with co-defendants in a robbery where a BB gun was displayed as a deadly weapon, there is probable cause to believe the defendant did commit the offense of Armed Robbery, 16-11-330.

**The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:**

On 12/29/2018 officers of the Myrtle Beach Police Department opened an investigation into an Armed Robbery that occurred on this date in the area of [REDACTED] which is located within the city limits of Myrtle Beach. The victim used a social media app called Grindr to meet with the Co-Defendant at the incident location. When the victim arrived at the location he was approached by the Defendant and a Co-Defendant who pointed what appeared to be handguns at him while demanding that he surrender his personal property. The victim was shown a photograph from the Grindr profile of the Co-Defendant and did identify it as the same photograph that he saw on the app. A SLED Facial recognition indicated the Grindr photo as a possible match for the Co-Defendant and a SC DMV photo confirmed the Co-Defendant's identity.

On 12/30/2018, the Co-Defendant was arrested for another Armed Robbery incident where he used the social media app called Grindr to lure another victim on 12/27/2018 at a nearby apartment complex called [REDACTED] which is also within the city limits of Myrtle Beach. The Defendant was at the same location as the Co-Defendant when he was arrested. In a post Miranda interview, the Co-Defendant admitted to using the Grindr app to communicate to three different people in the past three days and all three people have been identified as victims of Armed Robberies in the City of Myrtle Beach including this victim on 12/29/18. The Co-Defendant placed himself and the Defendant in the area and time of the Armed Robbery reported by the victim and admitted to knowing that the Armed Robbery took place. He specifically stated that the Defendant was the one who committed the Armed Robbery. Furthermore, the Co-Defendant identified the Grindr photo as himself when presented with the same photo that the victim viewed on the app.

Based upon the stated facts, that the Defendant did participate in a robbery with what appeared to be a deadly weapon, there is probable cause to believe the Defendant did commit the offense of Armed Robbery, 16-11-330.

The victim was shown a photograph from the Grindr profile of the Co-Defendant and did identify it as the same photograph that he saw on the app. A SLED Facial recognition indicated the Grindr photo as a possible match for the Co-Defendant and a SC DMV-photo confirmed the Co-Defendant's identity.

On 12/30/2018, the Co-Defendant was arrested for another Armed Robbery incident where he used the social media app called Grindr to lure another victim on 12/27/2018 at a nearby apartment complex called [redacted] which is also within the city limits of Myrtle Beach. The Defendant was at the same location as the Co-Defendant when he was arrested. In a post Miranda interview, the Co-Defendant admitted to using the Grindr app to communicate to three different people in the past three days and all three people have been identified as victims of Armed Robberies in the City of Myrtle Beach including this victim on 12/29/18. The Co-Defendant placed himself and the Defendant in the area and time of the Armed Robbery reported by the victim and admitted to knowing that the Armed Robbery took place. He specifically stated that the Defendant was the one who committed the Armed Robbery. Furthermore, the Co-Defendant identified the Grindr photo as himself when presented with the same photo that the victim viewed on the app.

Based upon the stated facts, that the Defendant did participate in a robbery with what appeared to be a deadly weapon, there is probable cause to believe the Defendant did commit the offense of Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Violent Crime, 16-23-490.






