The State with the Supreme Court on July 11, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of Richard K. Galloway v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 28, 2022.




for filing the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


