My condolences on the loss of your mother and please do not worry that you sent the wrong transcript because I am sure it was not your fault if that's what "they" sent you. It was surprising that you had the correct one to send to me the very next day.

If it would be possible for you to send me the original hard copy in the mail, I would appreciate it and you can deduct any costs from my refund.

Also, having the transcript from June 17, 2022 will actually be helpful in my appeal against Pet Helpers, Inc. and my ODC complaint against their lawyer because it illustrates further how biased the Charleston County Court of Pleas has been in this case and it shows clearly in both transcripts how the judges kept cutting me off and would not allowing me to defend myself or present evidence during either hearing, but consistently condescended to Pet Helpers in all their motions and requests. Judge Bonds wouldn't accept the photographs as exhibits that I presented, but Judge Price accepts an alleged adoption certificate from the Plaintiff's attorney without any supporting authentication. All the judges have acted accordingly throughout the lawsuit and that's the basis of my appeal. You have played a key role in bringing about justice in this matter when the entire truth eventually comes out. In one of the transcripts their attorney even says they were staging adoptions.

Two mistakes I noticed while reading the transcripts were:

Page 23 Lines 6-9 "I thought and believed that they (Pet Helpers) would be very conscientious, (not contentious) about finding him (Toby) a new home.

Also, I didn't tell Ms. Susko that I was coming back with "dog's army". I told her I would be back with God's Army.
