## ORDER

---

After careful consideration, Respondents' motion to dismiss is granted. The order on appeal is not immediately appealable. *See Grosshuesch v. Cramer*, 377 S.C. 12, 30, 659 S.E.2d 112, 122 (2008) ("[D]iscovery orders, in general, are interlocutory and are not immediately appealable because they do not, within the meaning of the appealability statute, involve the merits of the action or affect a substantial right."); *Sanders v. Savannah Highway Auto. Co.*, 432 S.C. 328, 335, 852 S.E.2d 744, 747 (Ct. App. 2020) ("[D]iscovery orders are interlocutory and not immediately appealable."); *Pendergrass v. Martin*, 275 S.C. 413, 272 S.E.2d 172 (1980) (an order granting an extension of time to answer a request for admissions is not immediately appealable). The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
