
Dear Ms. Pope:

ORDER

Respondents move to dismiss this appeal. Appellant opposes the motion and has filed motions to strike the motion to dismiss as well as respondents' reply to the return to the motion to dismiss. We find this appeal has been rendered moot in light of our decision in *Wilson v. Dallas*, Op. No. 27227 (S.C. Sup. Ct. refiled May 8, 2013), which, in part, remands the estate matter to the circuit court for further proceedings. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal. Appellant's motions to strike are denied as moot.
