

ORDER

After careful consideration, Respondents' motion to strike is granted in part and denied in part. Appellant-Respondent acknowledges that Argument II of her initial Respondent's brief contains an erroneous factual assertion—that the Appellate Panel held Appellant-Respondent was the direct employee of SCDC. Further, Appellant-Respondent consents to filing an amended initial Respondent's brief omitting that statement and has conditionally filed the amended brief. Accordingly, the erroneous statement shall be stricken and Appellant-Respondent's amended initial Respondent's brief accepted as filed. Respondents' request that Argument II be stricken in its entirety is denied.
