Appellant, received order's from the Court dated 4-14-22 and 5-16-22. —
"See appellant's Exhibit's #3 & 4. Court order's which States the issue being raised by appellant has been litigated numerous times, and no new evidence has been alleged, or submitted by appellant, in re: to Juror #38, Ms. Patricia B Gialther, committing a vior-Dire violation at appellants trial in Feb, 2008. — which is 100% not true, and did prejudice by committing perjury in the order's dated 4-14-22 and 5-16-22. "See appellants newly discovered evidence as stated in appellants Exhibit #2. Which States, on 1-11-22 appellant discovered that Juror #38 was employed in law enforcement at the time of appellants trial in Feb, 2008, and failed to disclose this fact during vior-Dire in which appellant would have struck Juror #38. 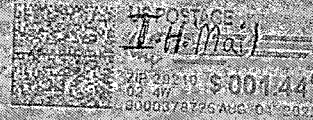
