Page 17, Lines 8-10: Changed "her" to "their"

Page 18, Line 6-7: No change was made.

Page 19, Line 21-23: No change was made.

Page 19, Line 25; Page 20, Line 2: changed "movement" to "movant", but left admitting. Omitting was not said.

Page 20, Lines 24-25; Page 21, Line 1: no change was made

Page 22, Line 9: no change was made

Page 23, Lines 2-6: no change was made

Page 24, Line 2: changed "leak "to "leave", but did not ad to supplement my answer, as it was not said.

on the phone yesterday. She checked their records and she said their office sent you the
audio of the April 22, 2022 hearing on June 14, 2022, but some months before that the
Plaintiff's attorney, Stephan Futeral, had requested a copy of the transcript of the June
17, 2021. hearing and they sent that to you at that time. Mr. Futeral cancelled his
request, but you still had that recording and apparently mixed the two audios up and
sent me the wrong transcript.

I will be sending you a list of errors I found in the unproofed transcript for April 22,
2022 today and hopefully I can avoid challenging the record if the final certified copy
still contains disputed entrees
