This matter came before me on the Plaintiff's Motion to Reconsider my Order of June 17, 2022. Representing the Plaintiff is Lee C. Weatherly of Carlock, Copeland & Stair, LLP. Representing Defendant Lisa Sulka is John E. Parker and Daniel E. Henderson of Parker Law Group, LLP.

The Plaintiff asks that I reconsider my Order of June 17, 2022. In that Order I granted Defendant Sulka's Motion to Reconsider and therefore denied the Plaintiff's motion for partial Summary Judgment. *See Landry v. Landry*, 430 S.C. 153, 161, 843 S.E.2d 491, 494-95 (2020) (defining a clerical mistake as an inconsistency between the text of an order and the court's intent and noting that a court may correct a clerical mistake pursuant to Rule 60(a) outside the ten-day jurisdictional requirement of Rule 59(e)).

After due consideration of all arguments, issues and evidence put forth by counsel with regards to Plaintiff's Motion for partial Summary Judgment and Defendant's Motion to Reconsider, including arguments advanced by counsel in hearings on both Motions, I believe my June 17, 2022, Order and its correction of my previous Order's clerical mistake is proper and therefore deny the Plaintiff's Motion to Reconsider.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the Plaintiff's Motion to Reconsider this Court's Order of June 17, 2022, is respectfully denied.
