Ms. Holmes,

I am requesting a copy of the audio for the hearing transcript of April 22, 2022, pursuant to South Carolina Code of Laws, Title 30, Public Records Chapter 4 **Freedom of Information Act**. I received the certified transcript of the hearing dated 4/22/22 yesterday via email attachment from Julie Cendroski, Court Reporter III Seventh Judicial Circuit, but in order to submit the corrections for the Challenge to the Record I need a copy of the audio for future use. I have lost all confidence in your office to produce an accurate transcript of the hearing after the multitude of mistakes that have occurred and your failure to take responsibility for the problems that it has caused me in my pursuit of my appeal on judgements rendered in the Court of Common Pleas, 9th Circuit.

As you know, on August 4, 2022 I received the wrong transcript overnight mail from the U.S. Postal Service. I notified all parties and on the next day, after staying up all night, Ms. Cendroski sent an un-proofed copy of the correct transcript of 4/22/22 via email attachment, that was full of errors. On August 3, 3033 her mother passed away, so she was experiencing bereavement when she learned of her mistake with the transcript. I sent Ms. Cendroski a list of the errors and she claimed she listened to the audio again, but she refused to correct all the errors. She then sent a certified copy yesterday, that is one page longer, and I found additional errors in that transcription. It's going to take me several days to proof-read it and list all the errors for the formal challenge letter.

Thanks for your cooperation in this matter. Since time is of the essence, I would appreciate a response within twenty-four hours about acquiring the audio.
