ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion to dismiss this appeal, contending Appellants failed to state the grounds for the appeal or alleged errors of law within the notice of appeal. After careful consideration, Respondent's motion to dismiss is denied. *See Allen v. Florence Pole & Piling, Inc.*, S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated Nov. 6, 2008 (stating an appellants' failure to state grounds for appeal or alleged errors of law in their notice of appeal from the Workers' Compensation Commission does not require the dismissal of the appeal because when provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act and the Workers' Compensation Commission Act conflict, the APA controls).
