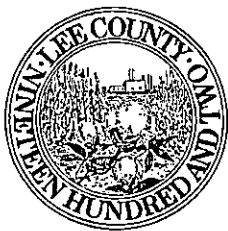

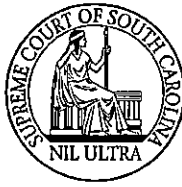
Dear Mr. Campbell,

TO: Clerks of Court

FROM: Adriane L. Radeker, Circuit Court Representative

RE: Motion and Affidavit to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* Filings—Case Numbers

DATE: December 11, 2012

CC: Circuit Court Judges

Please be advised that when a Motion and Affidavit to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* is filed, clerks of court should begin assigning common pleas case numbers (i.e. 2012-CP-40-XXXX) to these filings. If the motion is granted, all subsequent filings related to the action should be filed under the already established common pleas case number. If the motion is denied, the action should be disposed by the clerk using the CMS Disposition Code 65 and the clerk of court judge code 2099. Section 6.3.1 of the Clerk of Court Manual has been updated to reflect this change, and I encourage you and your staff to review it.

While some clerks have been assigning case numbers to these types of filings, this may not have been the general practice throughout the state. This procedure has been established to provide a method in tracking these actions in the CMS system as well as the appellate case management system.
