
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

In response to your letter on the continuing status of this matter, Mr. Boley remains in a Chapter 13 Bankruptcy, in which his payment Plan has been approved and on which he is making payments.

To repeat my explanation from earlier letters: if Mr. Boley completes the Bankruptcy Plan, he will then receive a discharge. This will render this appeal moot. If he does not complete the Plan, his Bankruptcy will be dismissed and the automatic Bankruptcy stay on this appeal will be ended. The Plan in question is for a period of five years, dating the first payment from May, 2010. Barring Mr. Boley's failure to make payments, his status will be unchanged until completion and discharge in ca. April, 2015.

I will be happy to supply any further information the Court requires on this matter. Thank you and your staff as always for your help in these matters.


