ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order of the Workers' Compensation Commission vacating the order of the single commissioner and remanding to a different single commissioner for a de novo hearing. The appeal is dismissed because the order on appeal is not immediately appealable. *See Bone v. U.S. Food Servs.*, 404 S.C. 67, 84, 744 S.E.2d 552, 562 (2013) (holding an order remanding to the Commission for further proceedings does not constitute final judgment and is not immediately appealable). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
