I have reviewed the letter regarding the incomplete transcript. I am certain the recording only picked up my voice as the court room was full of people. The attorneys at the hearing were at counsel tables without the benefit of microphones. The audio of my questions and interaction with counsel (I have not listened to the recording) was an attempt to ferret the issues which were sought to be addressed at the hearing. Because this case involved a subject matter jurisdiction question to the court, I did not take any testimony. I issued an order which addressed the prime issue in the case. I have prepared a simple order which I believe summarizes why a full transcript need not be created. I believe the order provides a summary of what my order (the appealed order) was based.
