- 1) Appellant is a inmate incarcerated within the perimeter of South Carolina Department of Corrections at Broad River Facility, 4460 Broad River Road, Columbia, S.C. 29210,
- 2) On July, 2022 Appellant (inmate) filed a notice of appeal with the South Carolina Court of Appeals,
- 3) July 15, 2022, South Carolina Court of Appeals Clerk transferred appellate case noll. 2022-000970 to South Carolina Supreme Court,
- 4) August 17, 2022, Appellant (inmate) filed a Affidavit of Indigency with the Office of Appellate Defense,

an order dismissing the appeal for failure to file a petition for writ of certiorari and appendix,

6) From July 15, 2022 thru August 16, 2022, Supreme Court clerk did not notify Appellant (inmate) that the appeal was docketed and file in the court. Appellant had no knowledge of the filing deadline. Appellant was not even given the chance to correct the deficiency on appeal,

11) Appellant (inmate) is not provided time in the facility law library to prepare or file the required papers with some type of legal professional assistance.
