2. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Amy N. Taylor v. The State



Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Justin Ryan Cone v. The State with this Court on August 16, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Ronnie M. Drake v. The State with the Supreme Court on August 3, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Reginald A. Dudley v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 18, 2022. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and the Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. DaJuan Young with this Court on July 6, 2022.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




