

Dear Mr. Goodwater:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption of your notice of appeal does not contain the title of the document or the names, addresses and phone numbers of the parties submitting the document.
- The notice of appeal has not been signed by all of the appellants as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- You must provide proof that the parties consented in writing or on the record at the hearing in the probate court to file this appeal directly with the Court of Appeals, rather than with the court of common pleas, as set forth in S.C. Code Ann. § 62-1-308(1).
