SECOND MOTION FOR AN EXTENTION

COMES NOW the Appellant, Patrick Lee Booker, who, proceeding pro se, hereby submit his Second Motion for An Extension of time to serve and file the initial brief of Appellant and designation of matter. The Appellant is requesting a sixty (60) day extension of time to serve and file the initial brief of Appellant and designation of matter. The current deadline to serve and file the initial brief of Appellant is September 6, 2022. The basis for this motion is set forth below:

GROUND/BASIS FOR MOTION

The first request for an extension was based upon the fact that Appellant was scheduled to attend a hearing before the Honorable Frank Addy, Circuit Judge, on August 15, 2022, regarding a matter directly related to the matter giving rise to this appeal. On that date Appellant attended the hearing and Judge Addy ruled upon the issue and stated that he would memorialize his decision via a written Order soon.
