The State opposed the Defendant's motion for bond. The State believes the Defendant is a flight risk as demonstrated by him initially fleeing after the alleged crime occurred. The State also believes the Defendant is a danger to the community based on his prior record and the violent nature of the offenses. Family members of the victim appeared in person and virtually for the hearing. Several family members addressed the Court and requested that bond be denied.

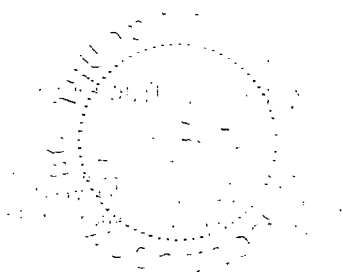




This matter came before the Court on November 12, 2021 upon the Defense's Motion to for a Speedy Trial.
