MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel respectfully requests a **final extension of thirty (30) days until June 28, 2013**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today, May 29, 2013. The Court has granted two previous extensions, **however, this is undersigned counsel's first extension request in this case.**
2. This case was assigned to Breen Stevens, whose last day with the Appellate Division was Friday, May 24, 2013. Undersigned counsel is assuming Mr. Stevens' caseload effective yesterday, May 28, 2013, and has been reassigned to handle the present case. **A separate letter is being sent**


to this Court today with a list of cases that undersigned counsel, Benjamin Tripp, is assuming. Counsel is working on and plans to file the petitions for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendices in the cases of Charles Gamble v. State and Howard Thompson v. State in this Court this week.


